## **Countermeasures against Influenza A(H1N1)**

On 18<sup>th</sup> July, influenza A(H1N1) infected persons in Kanazawa University has been confirmed, then the infected persons has been increased to more than 50. It seems that the infection is continuing to spread.

Under the situation, Kanazawa University decides the urgent countermeasures against the flu as indicated below.

1. Stop coming to University and refrain from going out
  - (1) The infected students have been prohibited from coming to the University. After recovery from the flu, they should follow instructions which will be given by doctors or Health Service Center of Kanazawa University.
  - (2) If you have symptoms of a fever or cough etc., you must NOT come to the University, and contact ~~“the Fever Consultation Center” (076-234-5102)~~ your nearest hospital and see doctors and follow the instructions given by them.
  - (3) The students who had close contact with the infected persons are requested to stay home. In this case, the students should check the health condition (ex. temperature check) for four days including the last contact date.

2. Classes and regular examinations
  - (1) Absence from the subjects in the first semester after July 21 is assumed to be excusable.
  - (2) When the student who corresponds to above-mentioned 1 is absent from the regular examinations, the makeup exam is guaranteed.
  - (3) When the student apply to the Student Affaires Section of your school or graduate school (or the Student Affairs Section of Liberal Arts if you are taking its subjects) for the makeup exam, please apply with the reason from (1) to (3) above mentioned 1(the medical certificate from the doctor or other documents are not required.)

3. Cancellation of classes and operation of regular examinations

Please confirm the bulletin board for the student and Acanthus Portal Site, and get the information about canceling the class and operation of regular examinations.
