


Hanyang's progress is a reflection of Korea's development







Transportation Hub

Seoul is the nation's center of financial, political, commercial, recreational, and cultural affairs. Fortunately, the Hanyang University main campus is located near the downtown area and situated next to a major transportation hub (Wangsimni Station) from which subways, trains, and buses can be easily accessed. 


HISS students are encouraged to immerse themselves in the local culture by finding housing themselves through services such as Airbnb.





Easy and simple, all on-line!



D-2-8 Short-term Study VISA

- Students from a visa-waiver country need to apply for <u>K-ETA</u>(Korea Electronic Travel Authorization) prior to your boarding. - Students from countries that are excluded from the Visa Waiver Agreement program must apply for a short-term study visa (D-2-8).
