Applicants must be

- a Japanese citizen
- a bachelor's degree student
- enrolled as a full-time student at his/her home university during the exchange period
- able to communicate in English
- interested in learning Thai culture
- excellent in interpersonal skills

## REQUIRED APPLICATION DOCUMENTS:

- NU Application Form
- Nomination letter from your university's International Office or Dean, which should contain information about endorsement for the applying student to take this exchange program
- Statement of Purpose
- Valid Passport (can be submitted after nomination)
- Full Coverage Health / Travel Insurance Plan (when arriving in Thailand)
- COVID-19 vaccine certificate

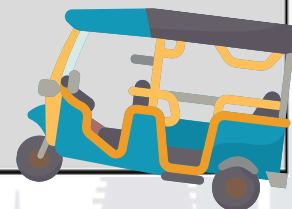
