The Kanazawa University Cancer Research Institute* invites applications for a full-time

professor or tenure-track associate professor (principal investigator) position.

*The Kanazawa University Cancer Research Institute (KU-CRI) bears the distinction of being the only institute solely focused on cancer research amongst the Research Institutes and Centers of Japan National Universities. Its mission is to promote basic research focusing on the "mechanisms of cancer malignancy" so to develop innovative diagnostics and treatments that utilize novel molecules and models, and cultivate professionals who will lead future cancer research and healthcare. In particular, the institute focuses on " understanding of the mechanisms of basic cellular functions," "interdisciplinary research with innovative technology," and "clinical data science", with the goals of (1) discovering new principles of life, (2) understanding the nature of cancer and (3) developing diagnostic and therapeutic methods for cancer. As a core research institute involved in cancer research in Japan, it also promotes joint use and collaborative research.

1. POSITION:

Professor or Tenure-track Associate Professor (principal investigator)

2. Compensation :

Annual salary system is applied.

3. RESEARCH AREA:

We are inviting applications for one professor or one tenure-track associate professor (principal investigator). The candidate will be required to promote cutting-edge research that contributes to elucidate the mechanism of cancer and develop novel diagnostic and therapeutic methods. We do not limit application to a specific field. However, we welcome applicants who are enthusiastic about building research systems closely linked to clinical practice, for example clinical data science or research utilizing patient-derived tissues and organoids, taking advantage of the fact that this research field is placed in the Takara-machi Campus, where the Graduate School of Medical Sciences and the affiliated hospital are located. Furthermore, you will be involved in pre-graduate and post-graduate professional education in the School of Medicine.

4. DATE OF EMPLOYMENT:

From January 1st, 2026 (immediately after contract of employment)

5. QUALIFICATIONS:

- (1) Applicants should have experience in the cancer research or related research fields with a strong publication record.
- (2) Applicants should be cooperative and highly motivated to perform research with faculty and staff members of the Institute.
- (3) Applicants must have a doctoral degree at the latest by the time when the appointment.

Reappointment review criteria:

- 1. Research activities: such as presentations of research papers and conferences
- 2. Educational activities: such as lectures and research supervision
- 3. Research funding
- 4. Contributions to the university and society
- [For Tenure-Track Associate Professor]

Outline for the standard in making decision on the approval of academic tenure:

- 1. Scientific achievement in the concerned field is outstanding in both domestic and international research communities.
- 2. Appropriately planned research is sufficiently achieved.
- 3. He/She obtains sufficient competitive research funding and performs high research activities.
- **Based on the result of intramural examination on academic achievement in research and activity in education, he/she may have opportunity for the reappointment or the promotion to a tenure researcher, after the expiration of one's term of office.
- After being granted tenure, he/she shall be subject to "Regulations Concerning the Term of Office of National University Corporation Kanazawa University Teachers".
 Based on the internal assessment results on his/her academic and educational achievements, reappointment is possible after the expiration of this term.
- (3) Kanazawa University promotes the development of diversity in the research and education environment.
