Notes on taking the exam

1 Examination venue and date

(1) Date and Time of the examination: December 6, 2025 (Sat)

(2) Examination venue: Natural Science and Technology Main Hall, and Natural Science and Technology Library Building, Kanazawa University Kakuma-machi, Kanazawa (Please check the attached campus map.)

(3) Venue Inspection: The guide map of the examination venue will be posted at the entrance of the examination venue G2 floor of the Natural Science and Technology Main Hall, from December 5, 2025 (Fri.) at 1:00 p.m.

(Entry beyond the examination venue entrance is not allowed.)

(4) Opening Time: December 6, 2025 (Sat.) 8:00 a.m. for the examination venue.

However, you may enter the waiting room for the oral examination from 1:30 p.m.

2 About the Exam admission ticket


(1) Please bring your “Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket” printed in A4 size on the day of the exam.

(2) After entering the waiting room for the oral examination (hereinafter referred to as “the waiting room”), place the “Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket” on the desk. Please note that you need to fold it in half to make the examinee's number, name, etc. visible.

(Note) ① If you did not bring your “Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket” on the day of the exam, please go to the Admission Examination Headquarters (試験場本部) by following the guide map at the examination venue entrance, and follow instructions from the staff.

② Keep the “Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket” until the admission procedure is completed and be careful not to lose it.

3 Precautions for taking the exam

(1) Please enter the waiting room with your belongings, etc. from 1:30 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. and take the seat with the same Examinee Number as found on the “Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket”.

(Check the location on the guide map at the entrance of the examination venue)

(2) Those who arrive at the waiting room later than start time of Oral Examination cannot take the exam.

(3) If you are found to have cheated (an act that affects the fairness and smooth progress of the exam) during the exam, you will be disqualified. Please refer to the guideline “Cautions about cheating in Kanazawa University Admission Examination” regarding the treatment of cheating.

(4) If you have a cough or any other symptoms, please wear a mask to protect others.

- (5) No relief measures will be taken even if daily life noises (e.g., footsteps of supervisors on patrol, meetings necessary for supervisory duties, sounds of aircraft, automobiles, wind, rain, air conditioning, coughing, sneezing, sniffing, brief ringing of mobile phones or clocks, chimes from surrounding buildings, etc.) occur during examination time.

4 Precautions during the Oral Examination

- (1) If you are wearing a mask or hat during the examination, the exam supervisor may ask you to take it off temporarily for identification purposes.
- (2) The use of electronic devices such as mobile phones, smartphones, wearable devices (including wrist watch type, earphone type, wristband type, smartwatches, smart glasses), electronic dictionaries, IC recorders, earphones, music players, and other electronic devices are not permitted in the oral examination waiting room. Watches with timekeeping functions only are permitted, on condition that alarm settings are turned off. Before entering the oral examination waiting room, be sure to turn off the alarm setting, turn off the power, and place them in a bag.
- (3) Please remain quiet and follow the instruction of the exam supervisor in the waiting room.
- (4) When your examination number is called, please move to the oral examination room with your Exam admission ticket and all your belongings.
- (5) After the Oral Examination, you will not be allowed to re-enter the waiting room.
- (6) To ensure fairness and objectivity in the evaluation of each examinee, the Oral Examination will be recorded.

5 Other

- (1) You are responsible for confirming the university's Application Guidelines for examination you will be taking.
- (2) Admission examinations are also held on other floors of the examination venue. Please remain silent at all times, including during and outside the examination hours.
- (3) Please prepare your own lunch (the campus cafeteria and stores are closed).
- (4) Smoking is not permitted on campus.
- (5) Traffic jams may occur due to snowfall, etc. please arrive at the examination venue early. And please refrain from using private vehicles and use public transportation.
- (6) If the examination time is changed due to unforeseen circumstances, the information will be posted on the Kanazawa University website, so please check it frequently.
