Notes on taking the exam

1. Examination venue and date

(1) Date and time of the examination: December 6,2025 (Sat.) from 12:30p.m.(Oral Examination)

Enter the Oral exam waiting room between 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.


- (2) Examination venue: General Education Lecture Hall, Kanazawa University Kakumamachi, Kanazawa City (Confirm the examination venue guide map.)
- (3) Information on examination room: Information about the examination room will be posted at the entrance of the examination venue from December 5,2025 (Fri.) at 1:00 p.m. (Entering the examination venue-building is not allowed.)
- (4) Opening Time: December 6, 2025 (Sat.) 11:00 a.m.

2. About the Exam admission ticket

- (1) Please bring your "Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket" printed in A4 size on the day of the exam.
- (2) Place the "Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket" on the desk. Please note that you need to fold it in half to make the examinee's number, name, etc. visible.

 (Example) How to place
 - (Note) (1) If you did not bring your "Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket" on the day of the exam, please confirm the sign at the examination venue entrance and go to the Admission Examination Headquarters and follow instructions from the staff.
 - (2) Keep the "Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket" until the admission procedure is completed and be careful not to lose it.

3. Precautions for taking the exam

- (1) Candidates should enter the oral examination waiting room with their bags, between 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. and take the seat with the same Examinee Number as found on the "Kanazawa University Exam admission ticket".
- (2) Those who arrive later than start time (12:30) of Oral Examination cannot sit it.
- (3) If the student is found to have cheated (an act that affects the fairness and smooth progress of the exam) during the exam, he/she will be disqualified. Please confirm to "Cautions about cheating in Kanazawa University Admission Examination" regarding the treatment of cheating.
- (4) If you have a cough or other symptoms of illness, please be considerate of other examinees by wearing a mask.

4. Precautions during the Oral Examination (Including Presentations)

- (1) You are not allowed to leave the waiting room during the oral examination waiting period Raise your hand and follow the supervisor's instructions in case of an emergency such as illness during the waiting for the oral examination or if you need to leave the room to go to use the restroom.
- (2) The use of electronic devices such as electronic dictionaries, mobile phones, smartphones, any types of wearable devices (including all types of watches, earphones, wristbands, smartwatches, smart glasses, etc.), tablet devices, IC recorders and music players are prohibited in the waiting room. Ensure all alarms are turned off and devices are powered down before entering. And put them in your bag without wearing them.
- (3) Earplugs are not allowed as they may prevent you from hearing instructions.
- (4) Please keep quiet in the waiting room for the oral examination by reading books, etc.
- (5) If you are wearing a mask during the examination, the supervisor may ask you to remove it temporally for identification purpose.
- (6) When your examination number is called, please move to the oral examination room with your Exam admission ticket and all your personal belongings.
- (7) For the presentation, you will be required to deliver an oral presentation on the given topic for approximately 5 minutes. Please note that this **will be an oral presentation only**, with no use of PC equipment or materials.

(8) The presentation topic is

Explain what kind of person you want to be in the future, including the following three items:

- What is a "social issue" that you are currently interested in and what are some "ideas" to solve it?
- What kind of "human society" do you want to achieve in 10 years?
- What kind of "smart technology" will you need to develop?
- (9) During the Oral Examination, we will question on an individual basis, keeping in mind the Admissions Policy.
- (10) After the Oral Examination, you will not be allowed to re-enter the oral examination waiting room.
- (11) To ensure fairness and objectivity in the evaluation of each examinee, the Oral Examination will be recorded.

5. Other

- (1) For examination details, please confirm the Application Guidelines issued by the University from applicant's responsibility.
- (2) Keep quiet even outside the examination time, not to mention during the examination.
- (3) You may bring drinks as the waiting time in the waiting room may be long. (Cafeterias will be closed).
- (4) Smoking is not permitted on campus.
- (5) Traffic jams may occur due to snowfall, etc., please arrive at the examination venue early and use public transportation and refrain from driving passenger cars to the examination site.
- (6) If the examination time is changed due to unforeseen circumstances, the information will be posted on the Kanazawa University website as the need arises
