1. Position:

Tenure Track Associate Professor or Non-tenured Assistant Professor

2. Affiliation:

Emerging Media Initiative, Kanazawa University

3. Field of specialization (Duties and Responsibility) :

We are seeking candidates who can promote research and education related to improving the security and reliability of information infrastructure and digital environments that support university-wide education, research, and administrative activities. The target areas include cybersecurity as a core field, as well as AI security, privacy-enhancing technologies, information governance, information networks, software engineering, cloud and distributed systems, risk management and business continuity planning (BCP), information ethics, Ethical, Legal and Social Issues (ELSI), and other related fields. The successful candidate will participate in university-wide cybersecurity initiatives, planning, operation, and enhancement of information infrastructure systems, incident response activities, and information education programs. The Emerging Media Initiative provides a unique opportunity to use real-world operational environments as a research platform. We welcome applicants who are motivated to generate new knowledge through practice and to translate research outcomes into societal impact.

4. School and Division (Teaching responsibility):

Liberal Arts and Science, Global Standard (GS) Courses for undergraduate and graduate programs

5. Subject responsible for:

Lectures and practical training courses on data science, information ethics, security literacy, computer, programming, and ICT-related subjects such as "Introduction to Data Science" and "Information Science"

6. Employment status:

A full-time tenure-track associate professor (non-tenured, 5-year term) or a full-time assistant professor (non-tenured, 5-year term)

An internal mid-term review will be conducted in the third year of employment, and a final internal review of research and educational achievements will be held at a predetermined time before the end of the appointment term. Based on the results of the internal review, if the candidate is reappointed, the new appointment will be without a fixed term (tenured).

For a tenure-track associate professor, upon successful completion of the internal review at the end of the term, a promotion to tenured professor or a transition to tenured associate professor is possible. If an extension of the tenure-track period (for a maximum of three years) is approved during the tenure review, a final review will be conducted in the last year of the extended period. (1) Activities related to the duties described in "3. Field of Specialization (Duties and Responsibility)."

(2) Research activities (e.g., publications, conference presentations).

(3) Educational activities (e.g., lectures).

(4) Acquisition of external funding.

(5) Contributions to the university and society.

7. Compensation:

Annual salary system is applied.

8. Qualification requirements:

- 1) The candidate should be a researcher with a doctoral degree by the time of appointment.
- 2) The candidate should have enthusiasm for research and education and be willing to actively contribute to the activities and operations of the Emerging Media Initiative.
- 3) The candidate should have outstanding research achievements in information security, information and communication engineering, network engineering, software engineering, artificial intelligence, data science, information systems, information governance, educational technology, or related fields.
- 4) The candidate should be willing to actively participate in cybersecurity promotion and information infrastructure enhancement activities. Advanced practical cybersecurity experience is not required at the time of appointment; however, applicants should have a strong willingness to acquire relevant knowledge and skills after joining the

Emerging Media Initiative and apply them to both operational activities and research.

- 5) The candidate should have sufficient communication skills in English and Japanese.

9. Start of employment:

The expected start date is April 1st, 2027 or the earliest possible date thereafter.

(An earlier start date (from March 1, 2027) may be possible upon consultation.)

- 8) Two referees (Name, affiliation, E-mail address and phone number)
- 9) Position the candidate would like to apply for (Associate Professor or Assistant Professor)

 - ✓ In the case of postal mail, submit the hardcopies of all the above documents together with the files in Word or PDF format on CD-R or USB flash drive.

12. Selection process:

After reviewing the submitted documents, shortlisted candidates will be requested to give a presentation (including a teaching demonstration) and undergo an interview. Please note that travel expenses for interviews will not be reimbursed. Candidates will be notified directly of the selection and interview results
